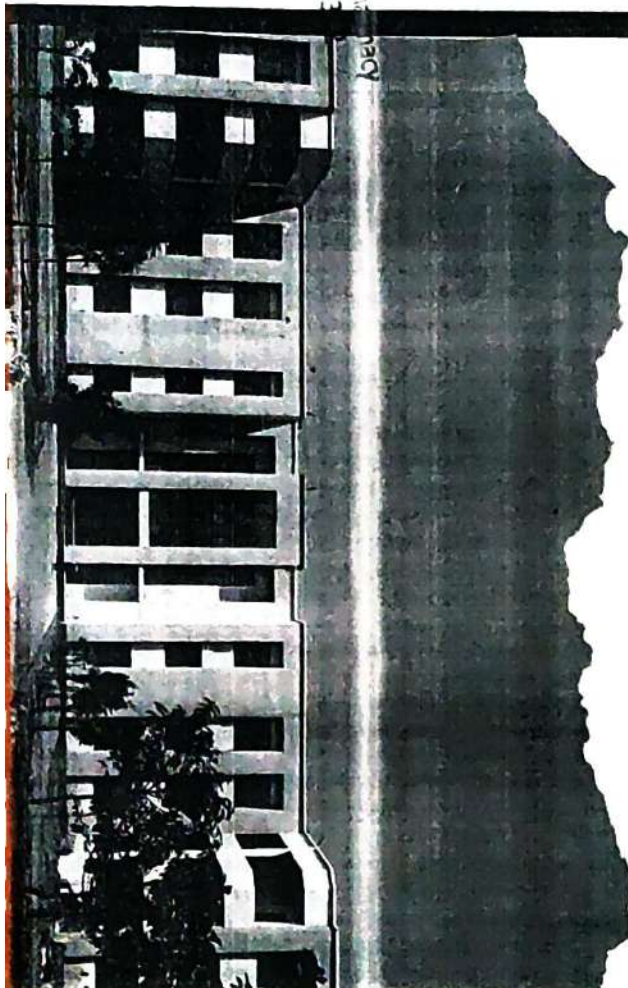

Summary:

Addon course on Herbal Drug Technology was conducted for students of B.Pharmacy final year. Herbal medicines have long earned reputation as "the people's medicines" because of their easy accessibility, safety, and the ease with which they can be prepared. Use of herbal medicines in the treatment of diseases has a long tradition of use outside of conventional medicines. The present workshop on Herbal Drug Technology dealt with the preparations of biologically active natural products that consist largely of herbs or herbal materials. It taught the students how to use modern analytical methods for discovery of any adulterants or for the bioassay or for knowing the purity of the phytoconstituents. It trained the students to know the basics of different methods employed for extraction, isolation and analysis of phytopharmaceuticals. Some of the screening techniques of antidiabetic activity, antiulcer activity, anti-inflammatory activity, analgesic activity and anticancer activity were conveyed to the students. Students were educated about different herbal formulations and herbal Cosmetics. The concept of nutraceuticals and its impact on health and diseases were dealt in detail. A glimpse was given about the Quality Control of Herbal medicine along with WHO and ICH Guidelines for Herbal Drugs. 19 students have enrolled for this course and all have successfully completed it with 75% attendance.

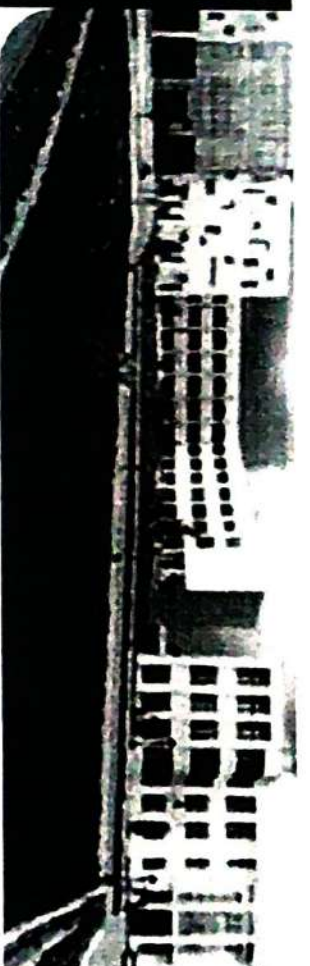

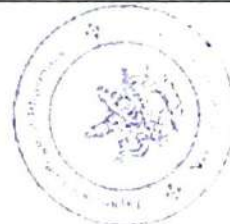

Such rules and guidelines often allow some flexibility, and the regulatory authorities expect companies to take responsibility for deciding how they should be interpreted. An insight was given to the students about some of the case studies along with providing the awareness on career and opportunities in regulatory affairs.



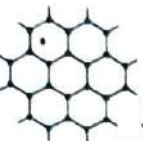
