SUMMARY:

For Pharm.D second year students, a certificate programme in functional food and nutraceuticals was offered that covered health-promoting dietary components and bioactive elements, their possible health consequences, and their mechanisms of action. Following completion of the course, the students were able to define functional foods and nutraceuticals, categorise functional foods, examine the potential health effects and mechanism of functional foods, and discuss the applications of functional foods in the industry. This course helped students to describe what functional foods and nutraceuticals are, classify functional foods, discuss the potential health implications and mechanisms of functional foods, and discuss the industry applications of functional foods. After completing this certificate course students developed the clear view on food application in treating diseases. This course gave insight about the relationship between the health and diseases. Summary:

Workshop on Herbal Drug Technology was conducted for students of B.Pharmacy final year. Due to their wide availability, safety, and simplicity of preparation, herbal medicines have gained the reputation of being "the people's medicines" for a very long time. There is a long history of using herbal medications in addition to conventional ones to treat disease. The preparations of biologically active natural products that primarily contain herbs or herbal materials were the focus of the current workshop on herbal drug technology. It taught the students how to employ cutting-edge analytical techniques to look for adulterants, conduct bioassays, and determine the purity of phytoconstituents. It taught the participants the fundamentals of several techniques used for phytopharmaceutical extraction, isolation, and analysis. It trained the students to know the basics of different methods employed for extraction, isolation and analysis of phytopharmaceuticals. 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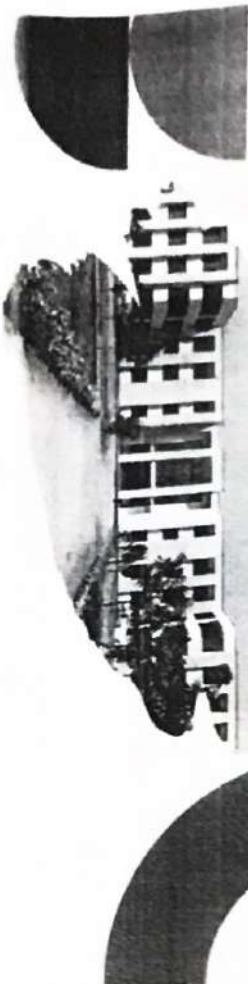
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SUMMARY:

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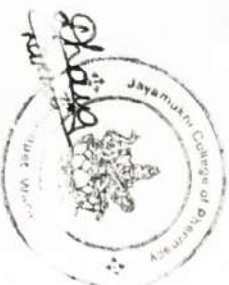
