### SUMMARY:

Workshop on Nanomedicine and Nano Formulations was conducted for B. Pharmacy Second year students. The course focused on uses of nanotechnology in therapy. In detail, the course covered clinical biomaterials, biocompatibility issues, tissue engineering including stem cells, and higher order structuring of engineered tissues. Furthermore, the course will covered nanoscale advanced drug delivery systems fundamentals, design, synthesis, and uses. In addition, environmental, physiological, cellular and molecular toxicological limitations of industrially encountered nanoparticles were covered. Owing to the properties conferred by the nanoscale, the challenges for nanotechnology implementation, specifically in the pharmaceutical development of new drug products and respective regulatory issues are critically discussed. In conclusion, concerns about the recent uses and projected advancements are discussed. The students received detailed information about the way that nanomedicines work, from disease diagnosis through disease therapy. 24 out of 29 registered students completed the course.





### **SUMMARY:**

## **SUMMARY:**

This workshop on antimicrobial stewardship was organised for Pharm. D 6<sup>th</sup> year students. Antibiotic stewardship is the effort to measure and improve how antibiotics are prescribed by clinicians and used by patients. Improving antibiotic prescribing and use is critical to effectively treat infections, protect patients from harms caused by unnecessary antibiotic use, and combat antibiotic resistance. The primary goal of antimicrobial stewardship is to optimize clinical outcomes while minimizing unintended consequences of antimicrobial use, including toxicity, the selection of pathogenic organisms, and the emergence of resistance. This workshop will equip Clinical Pharmacist/Clinicians who frequently prescribe antimicrobials with knowledge and tools to improve their use of these essential medications in daily clinical practice. Through case-based examples, the course will highlight how antimicrobial stewardship principles can be applied to common clinical scenarios. First foundational clinical knowledge necessary to use antimicrobials wisely will be reviewed. Then, illustrate how we can incorporate this knowledge into the management of patients with common infections through adherence to the five core competencies of appropriate antimicrobial prescribing. This course provided a framework for approaching each clinical encounter from the perspective of combating antimicrobial resistance. The certificate was given to each of the 16 registered students.
