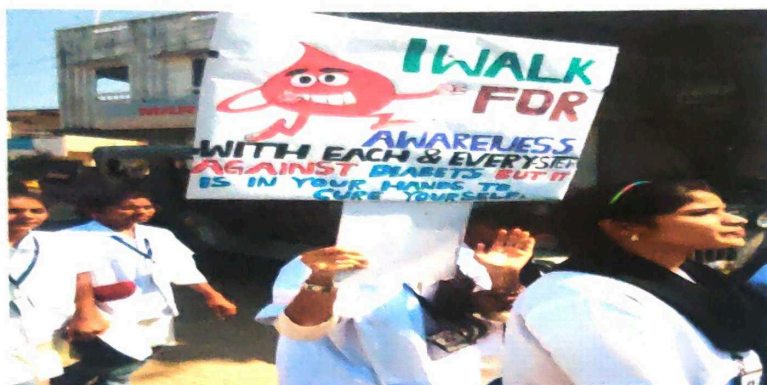

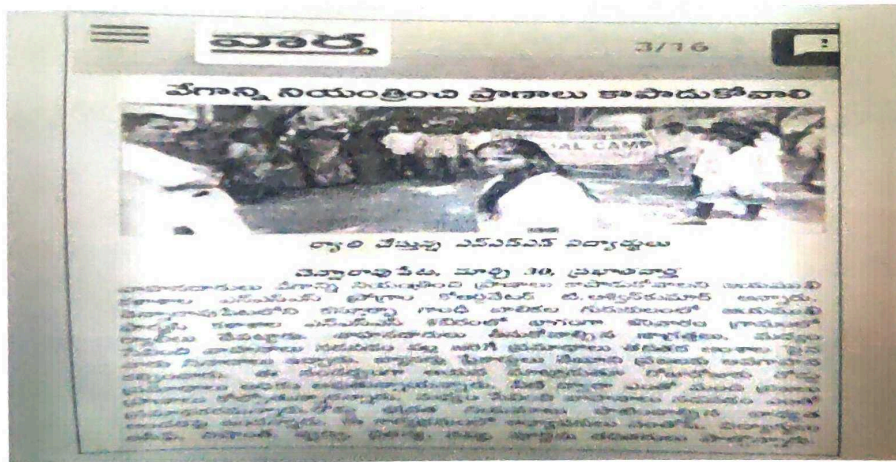
**Proceedings on Awareness about Road Safety and Early Marriages**

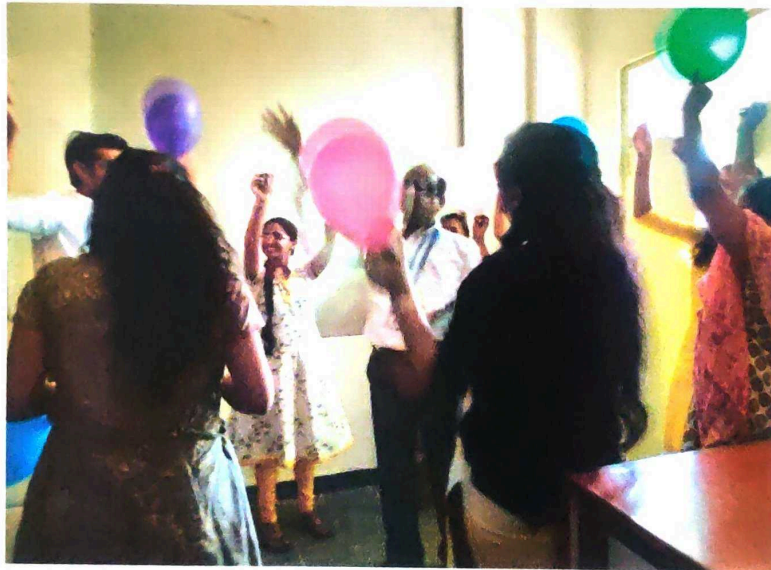


### Workshop on confidence buildup among students
