Please refur to CPC sLA's letter of even mi-dated 1º February, 2019 and 200 March, 2019 regarding mytric tions for animal brane facilities registered with CPCSFA (Copies enclosed). It has been noticed that establishments registered with the CPCSFA are smalle to comply the metric tions of the CPCSFA due to long term storage and retrieval of tootage of CCTV camera.

- 2. Therefore, the CPCSEA has decided that the CCTV shall be installed in the entry, exit and corridors of the animal house facilities/ shads and burns. The data of CCTV feedage shall be received by the Chairman and Member Secretary of IAEC every fortnight and they shall prepare a serumate regarding any no unitoward action in the animal house facility. The certificates shall be presented in the IAEC meeting before the CPCSEA Sommers.
- 1. The Committee has also decided for the following
 - i The presence of a full time veterinarian is mandatory in an arumal bouse facility. Exemption for part time veterinarian will be at the discretion of the CPCSEA on the basis of duration and number of animals being kept.
 - ii. In case of establishments having both large as well as small animal facilities/ farm within the same establishment, independent and dedicated veterinarian must be available at both large and small animal house tacilities, for upkeep of health and supervision of experiments.
 - iii. The Committee decided that the age limit for the internal members of the IAEC will be 65 years or till the date of their superannuation or whichever is earlier.
 - iv. With respect to number of Research Protocols to be discussed in one IAEC meeting, the establishment shall prepare its own SCR and decide the minimum number of the protocol to be taken in one IAEC meeting as per the mandate of the establishment.






