THIS CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into on the 19th January 2021 between

AND

Dr. S. Vasudeva Murthy, Principal, Jayamukhi College of Pharmacy, Narsampet, Warangal - 506 332, Telangana, INDIA. Phone: +91 8143635527 herein after referred to as "PI or Principal Investigator" for the SECOND PART)

ARJUNA and PI referred to herein as a 'Party' and collectively as the 'Parties'


WHEREAS the Parties possess certain non-public, confidential information relating to drug delivery technology and its intended use, which information they propose to disclose to each other ('**Confidential Information**') so as to enable them to use/market/advise/instruct each other on various strategic initiatives, (the 'Permitted Use');

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, ARJUNA and PI hereby agree as follows:

1. Either Party agrees to hold the Confidential Information in confidence in accordance with the provisions hereof. Such information may be in any form including but not limited to written or printed information or information in electronic form, data studies, consultants reports, trade secrets, Performa's, drug formulation and other financial, trade/commercial information, programs, contracts, plant designs and configurations, plant performance data or other material of any kind or nature in whatever form.
2. Either Party will not without the prior written consent of the other Party: (i) distribute or disclose to any other person any of the Confidential Information; (ii) permit any other person to have access to the Confidential Information; (iii) use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the Permitted Use; or (iv) disclose to any other person (A) the discussion, investigations or negotiations which are taking place concerning a possible transaction between the Parties, (B) the terms, conditions, status or other actualities regarding a possible transaction between the Parties, (C) that the Parties have received Confidential Information from a third Party. Notwithstanding the above, either Party agrees that they may disclose the Confidential Information, and portions thereof to the other Party's directors, officers, employees and authorized representatives of its advisors (collectively, "Representatives") who need to know such Confidential Information for the purpose of evaluating a possible transaction between the Parties. It is understood that both the Parties will inform its Representatives of the confidential nature of the Confidential Information and will require its Representatives to be bound by this Agreement and not to disclose the Confidential Information to any other person. Both the Parties agree to be responsible for any breach of this Agreement by its Representatives.

3. In the event that either Party is required by law or any judicial or governmental order or otherwise to disclose any Confidential Information, it must do so and provide the other party with notice of the same.
4. All Confidential Information shall be clearly marked or stated at the time of disclosure as being "Confidential" in order for such information to be deemed "Confidential Information" for purposes hereof and any Information disclosed to the Party by the other Party orally or visually and identified at that time as confidential shall be considered Confidential Information even if it is not reduced to tangible form and not marked as "Confidential" when transmitted to the other Party. Confidential Information does not include information that the Parties can reasonably prove, falls within any of the following: (i) information that either is legally in the Parties possession or in the public domain prior to the disclosure of such information (ii) information that, subsequent to its disclosure, has entered the public domain without any violation of this Agreement by the Parties; (iii) information that becomes legally available to the Parties does not, violate any contractual or legal obligation such third party has to the Parties with respect to such information; (iv) information that is independently acquired or developed by the Parties; or (v) information that is explicitly approved for release by written authorization of the Parties.
5. For purposes of complying with the obligations set forth herein, the Parties shall use all efforts fully commensurate with those that it employs for the protection of its own privileged and confidential information.
6. No license expressed or implied in the Confidential Information is granted to the Parties other than for the use of the Information in the manner and extent authorized by this Agreement.
7. Both the Parties agree that Confidential Information is and shall at all times remain the property of the respective Party. Both the Parties acknowledge that the Confidential Information is Confidential and material to the interests, business and affairs of the disclosing Party and that the disclosure thereof (other than as permitted under this Agreement) would be detrimental to the interests, business and affairs of the Party. No disclosure of Confidential Information is permitted except as otherwise provided herein and no grant under intellectual property rights is hereby given or intended, including any license (implied or otherwise).
8. Upon the request of either of the Party, the other Party will return or destroy all Confidential Information and any notes, correspondence, analyses, documents or other records containing Confidential Information, including all copies thereof, then in their or its Representatives possession. Such return, however, does not abrogate the continuing obligations of the Parties under this Agreement.
9. The obligation of each of the Parties to comply with the provisions contained herein excluding non disclosure of Confidential Information, shall continue for a period of five years commencing upon the date hereof.

Subject: Instructions of CPCSEA for the animal house facilities - regarding.

Sir/ Madam,

Please refer to CPCSEA's letter of even no. dated 1st February, 2019 and 29th March, 2019 regarding instructions for animal house facilities registered with CPCSEA (Copies enclosed). It has been noticed that establishments registered with the CPCSEA are unable to comply the instructions of the CPCSEA due to long term storage and retrieval of footage of CCTV camera.

2. Therefore, the CPCSEA has decided that the CCTV shall be installed in the entry, exit and corridors of the animal house facilities/ sheds and barns. The data of CCTV footage shall be reviewed by the Chairman and Member Secretary of IAEC every fortnight and they shall prepare a certificate regarding any/ no untoward action in the animal house facility. The certificates shall be presented in the IAEC meeting before the CPCSEA Nominees.

3. The Committee has also decided for the following.

- The presence of a full time veterinarian is mandatory in an animal house facility. Exemption for part time veterinarian will be at the discretion of the CPCSEA on the basis of duration and number of animals being kept.
- In case of establishments having both large as well as small animal facilities/ farm within the same establishment, independent and dedicated veterinarian must be available at both large and small animal house facilities, for upkeep of health and supervision of experiments.
- The Committee decided that the age limit for the internal members of the IAEC will be 65 years or till the date of their superannuation or whichever is earlier.
- With respect to number of Research Protocols to be discussed in one IAEC meeting, the establishment shall prepare its own SOP and decide the minimum number of the protocol to be taken in one IAEC meeting as per the mandate of the establishment.
